The Darrell Gwynn Foundation's "Track Walk for Those Who Can't" was held Sunday morning at Maple Grove Raceway on Stauffer Park Lane in Brecknock Township.

The foundation's mission is to provide awareness, prevention, support and ultimately a cure for paralysis. Gwynn was a professional race car driver who suffered paralysis as the result of injuries from a test run accident.

Several hundred fans and drivers - including National Hot Rod Association drivers Brandon Bernstein, Larry Dixon, Cory McClenathan and Greg Anderson - donated \$20 or more and walked the track together.

They raised at least \$4,000 for the foundation.
