WEST PALM BEACH, Fla. -- A West Palm Beach man who was paralyzed in a crash received a special gift from a former drag racer's foundation.

The Darrell Gwynn Foundation donated a \$22,000 wheelchair to Jeremy Lowery on his 28th birthday.

Jeremy Lowery received a new \$22,000 wheelchair on his 28th birthday thanks to the Darrell Gwynn Foundation.

Lowery was injured nearly 10 years ago in a crash while trying to

avoid hitting a deer. His vehicle overturned, and Lowery suffered a spinal cord injury that left him paralyzed.

Recently, Lowery's wheelchair was stolen from his apartment building. Without that wheelchair, Lowery's family and friends couldn't care for him, and he was forced to move into a nursing home.

Lowery thanked the foundation for its donation.

"I haven't sat up in over a year," Lowery said after getting in his new wheelchair.

He plans to move out of the nursing home and pursue a college degree in sociology.

Gwynn, who was injured in a drag-racing crash, started the foundation in 2002.
