The NHRA SuperNationals, one of the Full Throttle Drag Racing Series' original seven national events, returns for the 42nd year to Old Bridge Township Raceway Park in Englishtown, New Jersey, Thursday through Sunday, June 2nd through 5th. Formerly the SummerNationals, the event was originally run in July.

The SuperNationals mark the halfway point in the Full Throttle Series' regular season. In addition to the Top Fuel, Funny Car and Pro Stock divisions, Pro Stock Motorcycles are on the card.



“Big Daddy” Don Garlits will be on hand to celebrate the NHRA’s 60th anniversary at Englishtown, participating in meet-and-greets and autograph sessions, and Sunday morning’s Track Walk with a Legend. Garlits and Darrell Gwynn will also continue their Match Races for a Cause series. On Thursday, June 2nd, the track will host a racer-appreciation barbecue to benefit the Darrell Gwynn

Foundation, open to racers and fans for a \$10 donation.

Tickets are available through www.nhra.com. Thursday tickets are \$12 for adults, while Friday tickets start at \$37 for adults and \$10 for kids. Saturday final qualifying and Sunday elimination tickets start at \$49 for adults and \$10 for kids.
